Washing away the winter grime

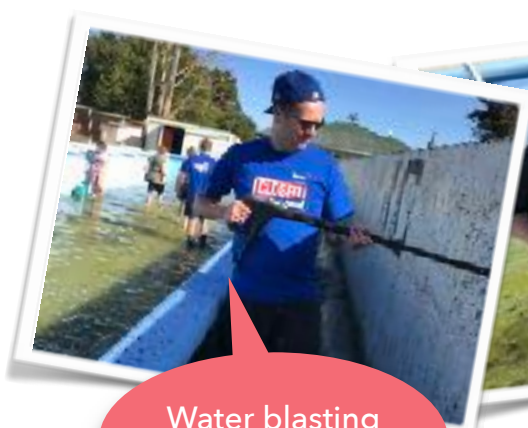
Parents are most welcome to join us from 11:00 am as we cut the ribbon and celebrate the new space. It is envisaged that the opening will run for approximately 45 minutes.
