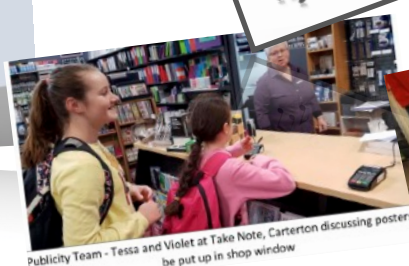
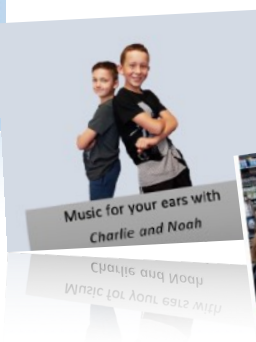
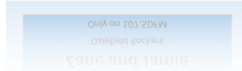
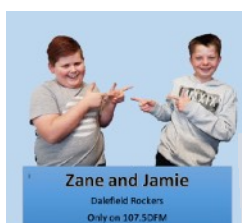


Kia ora Dalefield Whānau,
