"...We have a great big swimming pool here. I play with the older and younger children every day..."

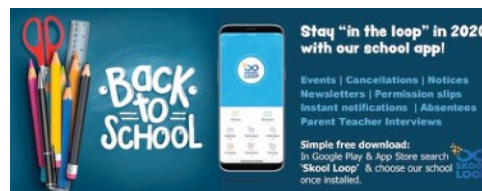

Dalefield School is a full state primary school serving the Dalefield, Carterton and Greytown districts since 1885. The school has a roll of between fifty and sixty students. The rural nature of the school has long been a source of pride for the community; and this is reflected not only in the tranquil setting close to the foothills of the Tararua ranges, but in the culture of the school. Our children flourish in the small family atmosphere and are encouraged to be part of the wider community.

In June 2019, 107.5DFM went live. Our school's radio station is a fantastic vehicle for our students to develop communication skills and build confidence. Our older students organise and run the station with input from all ages including interviews, stories, quizzes and news items. We have a studio space which is being upgraded this year.
